

## City of Alamosa Dog Park Rules

- Hours of Operation - City Dog Parks are open from dawn to dusk 7 days a week
- All other City of Alamosa Park Rules apply including the prohibition of weapons
- Dogs MUST be within sight and under voice control of the owner at all times and not left unattended
- Dogs MUST be on a leash prior to entering and upon leaving the facility and dog owners must be in possession of a leash at all times inside the park
- The City of Alamosa is not responsible for injuries to dogs, their owners/handlers, or others who use the park. This area is for dogs and their handlers only
- Limit of 3 dogs per adult
- Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and their dog's actions
- No smoking or food (human &/or dog) within the park
- Dogs must be current with all vaccinations, healthy, and wearing a collar with identification and current rabies tag at all times
- DOG WASTE MUST BE CLEANED UP IMMEDIATELY BY THE DOG OWNERS AND PLACED IN THE TRASH RECEPTACLES PROVIDED
- Dogs in heat and puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited
- Animals other than dogs are prohibited
- Do not bring dogs to the park that you cannot handle
- Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult
- Dogs showing aggression towards people or other dogs MUST be immediately removed from the park
- Dog owners are responsible for filling holes and repairing damage caused by their dogs
- Violators are subject to removal from the dog park, suspension of privileges, and possible criminal charges

**Note: The Blanca Vista Dog Park has water access and dogs can easily escape confinement by swimming beyond the fenced boundaries or simply going out on the ice when the pond is frozen. Dog owners remain responsible for controlling their dogs regardless of the location**

- *Reporting – Any incident, problem, violation, emergency, etc. must be reported immediately to the Police Dispatch at 719-589-5807. Call Alamosa Parks and Recreation Department at 719-589-2105 for maintenance or operational concerns.*
- *Responsibility – Any person bringing a dog into this facility assumes the legal responsibility, jointly and severally, with the owner of the dog for any damage, disease, or injury to persons, other dogs, or property, caused by the dog. All persons using the facility, by entering it, agree to indemnify the City of Alamosa and hold the City of Alamosa harmless for any harm resulting from the use of this facility.*
