

City of Alamosa Parks, Trails and Open Space Rules


- **Hours – City Parks are open 5am - 10pm; Trails, Open Space and Dog Parks are open dawn to dusk**

(Unless otherwise posted or authorized by Alamosa Parks and Recreation)

- **Overnight camping, tents, enclosures, or other unpermitted structures such as bouncy castles or the sale of goods and services are prohibited**

(Unless otherwise posted or authorized by Alamosa Parks and Recreation)

- **Knives or any other dangerous instrument capable of inflicting cutting, stabbing, or tearing wounds having a blade of over 3.5 inches are prohibited with the exception of hunting or fishing knives carried for sports use. Except for law enforcement officers in the lawful discharge of their duties, possession or use of deadly weapons, as that term is defined in C.R.S. § 18-1-901(3)(e), including firearms, bludgeons, or any other weapon intended to be used or capable of death or serious bodily injury are also prohibited. Bows and arrows are permitted at the archery range. Licensed concealed carry of firearms remains permitted but is discouraged.**
- **Alcohol (unless otherwise authorized by Alamosa Parks and Recreation), illegal drugs, discharge of firearms and/or fireworks, tagging, graffiti, hunting, camping, campfires (excluding existing grills – extinguish coals completely after use), and disturbing the peace are prohibited.**
- **Littering, harm to wildlife or plants, and/or vandalism to trees and park structures are prohibited.**
- **Pets must be on a leash and under the physical control of their owner at all times. Pet owners are responsible for prompt clean up and proper disposal of pet waste in trash receptacles or carried out of the premises by the owner.**
- **Use of profane, threatening, or abusive language & engaging in disorderly/lewd conduct is prohibited**



- **Motorized vehicles are prohibited in non-designated areas except emergency, maintenance, pedal-assist e-bikes, and ADA service vehicles**
- **Smoking and the use of any and all tobacco/marijuana products (including the use of electronic smoking devices) is prohibited within 20 feet of playgrounds, ballfields, other recreational facilities, or any ongoing Parks and Recreation program/class/activity**

The use and enjoyment of City Parks is at your own risk.
